The second week of the Tyler 4, the Lone Star Round Up, was a big improvement with respect to the weather. The Texas Pre Green Super Stake was held on Thursday with 20 horses competing for the \$5000 in prize money. Peter Pletcher came away with the top three spots winning on his horse Serena (pictured below), second on XOXO owned by Forest Hill Farm and third on Sandriaano owned by Sue Lightner. Peter also finished in the same order in the USHJA Pre Green Incentive.



On Friday in the hunter ring, the \$20,000 USHJA International Derby was front and center with 29 entries.

Fleur de Lis Farms', Bowie, ridden by Courtney Calcaginni (shown below) took home the blue. Chique SM owned by Linda Heathcott and Spruce Meadows and ridden by Peter Pletcher was second and Happy Hour owned by Eighteen Acres Farm and ridden by Mindy Coretz was third.



In the jumper ring, the \$5000 EMO Jumper Classic which was won by Rockaway owned by EJAT, LLC, and ridden by Martien Van der Hoeven. Second went to GPS Evita owned by Palindrome Investments and ridden by Chris Nelson and third went to Magic Mike owned by Mikayla Foster and ridden Celine Myers.

The \$30,000 Grand Prix was Saturday afternoon with riders looking great in Kingsland polo shirts, provided by Exceptional Equestrian. Frank Owens had a great day producing the only two clear rounds. He was a good sport and jumped off MTM Twenties Girl and Capricello 2, both horses being owned by DS Holdings. He finished first and second, respectively. Third, and the Kastel Denmark award for the top female rider, went to Julie Cleveland Beam. During the Grand Prix, exhibitors and guests were treated to a great dinner sponsored by the Texas Hunter and Jumper Association.
